The Digestive System Laboratory

Instructions: Place a couple of biscuits (food) in a clear, re-sealable storage bag (stomach) Add some water to the bag and seal the top tightly. Encourage students to pretend their fingers are the muscles inside their stomach, mashing and digesting the food. Wait for 1-2 hours and observe how the food is digesting.

3 Chewing. Another way to illustrate human digestion is to watch the breakdown of hard candies. Take four separate baby food jars and four pieces of hard candy. 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First we mashed the food using a fork, just like your teeth would in your mouth. Next we added water (saliva), green water for bile, orange juice for acids in your stomach and then squeezed it down the leg of a pair of tights. To make the food move along we used our hands to show peristalsis.

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
